This competition will take place in Blaenau Ffestiniog from 30th June to 2nd July 2023.

The 3rd Moelwyn International Acrobatic Gymnastics Cup is open to Club, Regional and National teams.

This competition will be in accordance with British and FIG regulations for the following age groups and categories:

Competition Rules

Qualifications and Final (Grades 1-4): 1 Combined Exercise Qualifications and Final (Grade 5 & IDP): 1 Balance Exercise & 1 Dynamic Exercise

Qualifications (Youth): 1 Combined Exercise (Difficulty is calculated as in FIG – Age Group 1) – 2.30"Min max duration. Qualifications (Age Group 1 / Age Group 2 / Junior / Senior): 1 Balance Exercise & 1 Dynamic Exercise.

Finals Start From Zero (0).
The number of finalists depends on the number of pairs / groups in the category.
(1-8 P/G = 6 Finalists. 9-16 P/G = 8 Finalists. 16 plus P/G =10 Finalists.
Finals for Grade & IDP will follow FIG Age Group 1 Final Rules for 2020.
Finals(Youth): 1 Combined Exercise
Finals (Age Group 1):
Balance or Dynamic in accordance with FIG Rules.
Finals (Age Group 2 / Junior / Senior):
Combined Exercise.

Youth Rules

General Rules:

Pairs: choose 2 balance elements from 11-16 difficulty tables + 1 optional element from FIG tables and 2 dynamic elements from 11-16 difficulty tables + 1 optional element from FIG tables (OPTIONAL can be from 11-16 difficulty tables but not the same ROWS used on the compulsory elements).

Groups: choose 1 pyramid from 11-16 difficulty tables + 1 optional pyramid from FIG tables (**only 2 static holds of 3**" **are required in the routine**) and 2 dynamic elements from 11-16 difficulty tables + 1 optional element from FIG tables (OPTIONAL can be from 11-16 difficulty tables but not the same ROWS used on the compulsory elements).

Individual: 3 individual elements must be executed – no matter if it is cat 1 or cat 2 (*NO SALTO REQUIRED*).

<u>Media</u>

Media personnel must request special accreditation from the OC. Please contact the OC at the time of nominative entry to be eligible for media accreditation. The media personnel will be assigned media areas in the field of play and will need to agree to the media code of conduct. S&G Media will be the official event photographers for the event. S&G will be providing the competition with routine photos, routine film and a livestream service.

Accreditation

Accreditation Location : Competition Venue Accreditation Times : Friday as per podium training schedule The accreditation system identifies individuals participating in the competition and ensures controlled access to each area. All participants and officials are required to wear accreditation cards at all times.

At accreditation, the Head of Delegation must check the correct names of their delegation, verify accommodation requirements. A delegation pack will be given to the Head of Delegation. Accreditation is personal, non-transferable. Accreditation is required to access training and competition zones, official transport and meals.

Without your accreditation card, you cannot pass the security control and you cannot participate in lunches, dinners, etc. If you lose your accreditation card, you will have to buy a new one for the price of $\pounds 10$

When all the commitments are fulfilled, all delegation members will receive their accreditations.
